### Judging:

- Trophies will be presented to the 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> Place Teams (both Nobles and Daughters).





Each team will have 3-5 minutes to execute their routine. Originality of routine Synchronization of team members Compliance with guidelines.

#### **Restrictions:**

- The use of or display of any ritualistic signs or vulgarity will result in immediate disqualification. "Hump Riding" (one team member on another member's back) is not permitted.
- Vulgar or obscene gestures and/or language are not permitted. Routine must not include or require members to crawl or lie on the floor.
- Routine must be performed in the space designated. Competition uniform and inspection uniform must be the same.
